

NSW Libraries Science Display Contest



Terms and Conditions

1. Promoter

The promoter of this competition is Inspiring Australia NSW, in collaboration with Children's Discovery.

2. Eligibility

2.1 Entry is open to all NSW public libraries.

2.2 Each library may submit one entry only unless otherwise specified.

2.3 Employees of Inspiring Australia NSW and Children's Discovery, their immediate families, and associated agencies are not eligible to enter.

2.4 NSW public libraries that received a 2026 grant from Inspiring Australia are not eligible to enter.

3. Competition Period

3.1 Registrations open on Monday 1 June and close on Monday 20 July 2026

3.2 The competition closes on Friday 28 August 2026

3.3 Entries received after the closing date will not be accepted.

4. How to Enter

4.1 Participating libraries must complete the competition entry form available on the Inspiring Australia website <https://inspiringnsw.org.au/projects-4/engage-your-community-nsw-libraries-science-display-contest/>

4.2 Your Science Week Library display must be registered on the National Science Week website: <https://www.scienceweek.net.au/login/>

4.3 Only one entry per library is allowed unless otherwise specified.

5. Prize

5.1 The prizes include:

1. \$500 Children's Discovery pack
2. \$250 CSIRO book pack and a National Science Week Pack*
3. National Science Week Pack
 - a. National Science Week Pack includes available merchandise: t-shirt, keep-cup, hat, badges and stickers
